Dear Parents,

Another summer is almost upon us and we are getting ready for our youth Horsemanship Camps. We are looking forward to seeing all of our 'old' campers again, and welcoming the new campers. We have lots of fun activities and good times planned with the horses. So get ready to plan your child's summer at Wells Stables.

If you have never been to our facility, our primary goal is to teach safety around the horses! Our groups are small and carefully monitored. The camper will learn many things about horses. They will learn the different colors, sizes, and shapes of different breeds of horses. They will also learn how to care for a horse and its environment by receiving hands-on experience grooming, cleaning, caring for, and riding the horses here at the stables. We will be going on a field trip to a local farm during the week so that your child can see different breeds of horses and observe other things that horses can be used for. There will be games and learning activities all throughout the afternoon. If there is time, we will also take them to the city pool for a break from the heat.

The last day of camp we like to share with the parents. Wells Stables will provide a pizza party for the campers and the parents. There will be a play day that evening so that your camper has a chance to show-off what they have learned and the crafts they have created.

When you come, bring your child in shorts and tennis shoes. We ask that your child bring the following items:

- **bathing suit**
- **towel**
- **long pants**
- **boots or shoes with heels.**

**Each camper will need to bring a lunch and a snack with him/her every day.** We will provide water and Kool Aid. They will be eating about 4:00 in the afternoon. **Parents, you will need to feed your child before they come so that they can make it until the lunch/dinner hour.**

Our stable is located 4 miles NorthWest of Los Fresnos, Texas off of FM 803 on Stanford Rd. Our signs are on HWY 100, FM 803, and Stanford Rd. Watch for them on your way.

Horsemanship camp charge is \$450 per week. **A \$100 deposit per camper is required to reserve the week of your choice.**

We require all riders to wear a protective riding helmet. **We will furnish one if you do not have your own.** We try to take every precaution to insure the safety of your child, but in case of a problem we like to be prepared. Please mail or deliver the following forms –with your deposit- back to me as soon as possible to insure your child's place in the camp. We fill our slots very quickly.
